**Loop Brace and Start/End Markers**

The loop brace and start/end markers must first be selected	
Move Start Marker to Position	Shift -click
Nudge Loop Left/Right	right/left arrow
Move Loop By Loop Length	up/down arrow
Halve/Double Loop Length	CTRL up/down arrow
Shorten/Lengthen Loop	CTRL right/left arrow
Select Material in Loop	CTRL - Shift - L

Tab can be used to move from one track or scene to another while renaming.
